During the day Ian Muir will be dealing with playing in general, and in particular will spend time on:-

The characteristics of the Reel, Jig and Strathspey with particular emphasis on the feel for the music.

Although designed principally for accordions, fiddles, keyboards and drums, the Day School can accommodate other melodic and rhythmic instruments. The morning and afternoon sessions will be divided between massed playing and specific groupings for technique.

It is hoped that the musicians will stay to join Ian Muir in playing for the Border Branch Day School Evening dance.

Players are expected to have a good working knowledge of their instrument.

Players should bring music stands, and keyboard players must bring their own keyboard, as there are no pianos.

Music will be provided prior to the day, for preparation.

Numbers may have to be limited and the organisers reserve the right to arrange a balance of instruments.
